AB 319 (Stone) – Connect the Cap **SUPPORT**

- This bill will require that all single-use plastic bottles sold in California have the cap connected to the bottle thereby preventing litter, increasing recycling, and helping California meet its 75% recycling goal.
- Plastic bottle caps are the **3**rd **most commonly littered item** found at California's beaches and waterways during annual cleanups. This and their additional detriment to streets and parks all contribute to the \$428 million per year municipalities in California spend on litter cleanup. Nearly 5 billion bottle caps are not recycled, and escape into the environment every year.
- If we don't reduce plastic pollution entering the marine environment, by 2050 there will be more plastic in the ocean than fish. Connected caps is an easy way to reduce plastics in both inland and coastal waters.
- In the 1970s, the beverage industry solved the litter problem caused by aluminum pull tabs by designing a connected push tab. Then they moved to plastic bottles and repeated the design flaw. **The technology already exists** and is being used, for example, by the biggest bottled water manufacturer in the U.S., Crystal Geyser, who supports the bill. Their cap uses less plastic and saves them money.
- Consumer education won't solve this. Industry (APR) has had a CAPS ON education program since 2010 it hasn't worked as demonstrated by no reduction in bottle cap litter during Coastal Cleanup Day.
- Recyclers throughout California want the caps. The biggest bottle recycler in the U.S., Carbon-Lite based in Los Angeles, supports the bill.
